Domaine du Pavillon Cote Roannaise 2009

Beaujolais is only 50 miles away, but a more different expression of Gamay can't be found. This wine sells out fast in France so it is a rare pleasure to drink it in America.

Domaine Chofflet-Valdenaire Givry Rouge 2009

A stylish and superb Red Burgundy value made 100% from Pinot Noir from a dedicated grower.

Two Selections from Domaine de la Butte Bourgueil (Loire)

Jackie Blot produces intensely flavored red wines from Cabernet Franc and is an emerging superstar. **Le Pied de la Butte** comes from the lower portion of the slope and offers generous black cherry

The rare and outstanding **Le Haut de la Butte** (from the highest part) is a deep and complex knock-out.

Domaine Paul Autard Chateauneuf-du-Pape 2006

This great wine has a dense and powerful finish which makes it our happy finish as well!
